Parents and Guardians,

I would like to begin by thanking you for helping us to get the 2021-2022 school year off to a great start. Student attendance has been great and they all appear to be excited to continue in-person learning.

As you are probably already aware, Governor Wolf announced a face covering mandate on September 1, 2021 for all K-12 schools across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This mandate will go into effect on September 7, 2021. Unlike the recommendations as presented throughout the summer, this is an Order mandated by the Pennsylvania Secretary of Health as communicated by Governor Wolf. As a public charter school, we are legally obligated to comply with the Order as directed.

When school resumes on September 7, 2021 after celebrating Labor Day, all students, staff, and visitors **MUST** wear a mask covering their nose and mouth while inside our facilities, regardless of their vaccination status. Again, this is a mandated Order that everyone must be in compliance. Ketterer Charter School will have masks available for those entering our buildings who are in need. As part of the Order, masks will **NOT** be required for students, staff, and visitors when engaged in an activity that cannot be performed while wearing a mask, such as eating and drinking.

We appreciate the cooperation of our students, families, staff, and community members as we comply with these newest orders from the State level. While we understand and respect that there are many views on this topic, we all must agree to work together to make this school year the best it can be. Thank you for your continued work to keep Ketterer Charter School a safe and special place for our students.
